





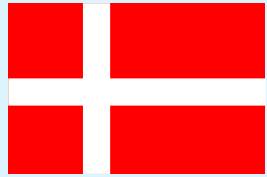

DENMARK



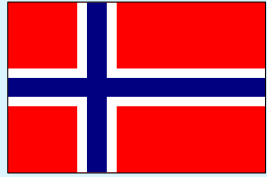
- **In September 2009 a new education began in emergency management and risk assessment. The education period is three and a half year, changing between theory and practice. After graduation the students have earned a bachelor degree.**
- **The Tetra network has almost been rolled out throughout the whole country. However there are severe problems in the control rooms. Terma can not deliver the needed software, so the control rooms have been allowed to implement/configure their own software. This in turn has led to numerous autonomous situations. The 112-centrals are not incorporated in the Tetra system.**

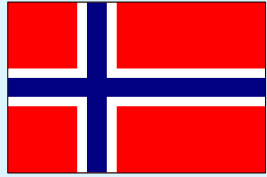

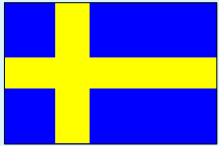

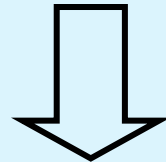
- **New national goals for fire safety**

 - **Less loss of property**



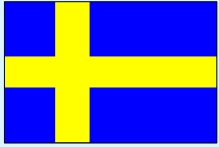

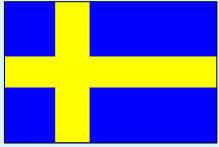

SWEDEN



- **New Statistics on Fire Deaths
(30 % more)**
- **Tragic Domestic fires with 12 deaths in just two fires – One apartment and one villa
(2 mothers and 10 children)**
- **Increased number of School fires with more than 50 % arsons
Around 600 fires a year and 300 arsons**



SWEDEN



- **Follow up on the Civil Protection Act from 2004**
- **Government Assignments:**
 - Domestic fires
 - School fires
 - Fire knowledge by the people
 - Local Fire Inspections
 - Government inspections of the Municipal Fire and Rescue Service
- **Basic Training for part time Fire Fighters**
- **The Act on Explosives and Flammables 2010**
