MEMORIAL A

No. 883 of 17 December 2021

Regulation of the Government in Council of 15 December 2021 fixing the allowances provided for in Articles 16, paragraph 1^{er}, 18 and 20, paragraph 1^{er}, of the Grand Ducal Regulation of 14 June 2015 on travel and subsistence expenses and on removal allowances for civil servants and State employees.

The Government in Council,

Having regard to Article 29 of the amended Act of 25 March 2015 laying down the salary system and the conditions and procedures for the promotion of State officials;

Having regard to Articles 16, paragraph 1^{er}, 18 and 20, paragraph 1^{er}, of the Grand Ducal Regulation of 14 June 2015 on travel and subsistence expenses and removal allowances for civil servants and State employees ;

On the proposal of the Prime Minister, Minister of State and after deliberation ;

Stop:

Art. 1^{er}.

The allowances provided for in Article 16, paragraph 1^{er}, of the Grand Ducal Regulation of 14 June 2015 on travel and subsistence expenses and removal allowances for civil servants and State employees are fixed as follows:

1. day allowance: 14 euros ;
2. night allowance: 56 euros.

The allowance provided for in Article 18 of that Regulation shall be EUR 1.

Art. 2.

The allowances provided for in Article 20(1)^{er} of that Regulation shall be as follows

Art. 3.

For countries holding the Presidency of the Council of the European Union, the ceiling amounts for the night allowance are increased by 10 per cent for the duration of the Presidency.

Art. 4.

The regulation of the Government in Council of 18 December 2020 fixing the allowances provided for in Articles 16, paragraph 1^{er}, 18 and 20, paragraph 1^{er}, of the Grand-Ducal regulation of 14 June 2015 on travel and subsistence expenses as well as on removal allowances for civil servants and State employees is repealed.

Art. 5.

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1^{er} January 2022.

Art. 6.

This Regulation shall be published in the Official Journal of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.
